



How Much Are District 1199C Dues?

Amount District 1199C says members pay...	Amount you may have to pay the union every year <u>just to keep your job if 1199C represents you...</u>	Amount you may have to pay during a 3-year <u>District 1199C contract just to keep your job...</u>
2.15% of actual base wages + \$3.90 up to \$53.70 every month	\$644.40 every year	\$1,933.20 over 3 years

District 1199C reported to the federal government that its monthly dues range between \$27.30 and \$53.70 per month. This amount is on the LM-2 report that 1199C filed with the U.S. Department of Labor on Mar. 29, 2019. (File Number 504-072.)

- District 1199C labor contracts typically require employees they represent to pay union dues or fees just to keep their jobs with their employer.
- This requirement exists in the union's contracts at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital, Temple University Hospital and at other hospitals.

If District 1199C wins the right to represent you and you don't pay them, the union may negotiate the right to demand that you be FIRED!
